160 girls were inspired.

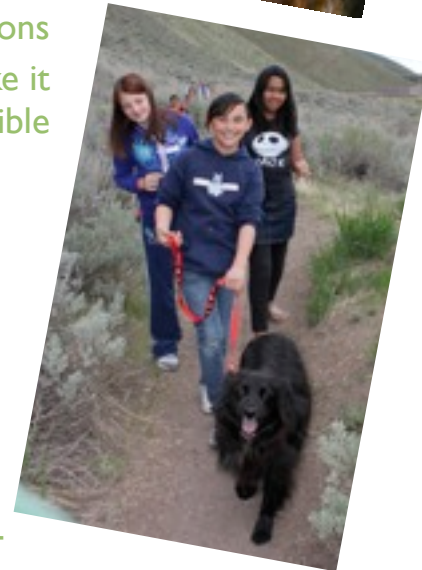


128 financial contributions were made to help make it all possible
